2024–2025 Program Outcomes Summary

Program Outcomes

- Number of Graduates (2025): 13 graduates
- Degree Completion Rate: 85% completed within 2–3 years
- Licensure/Certification Examination Pass Rate: 73% passed NCE, NCMHCE, or CRC
- Combined Employment / Doctoral Placement Rate: 100% employed within 3 months

Narrative Summary of Outcomes

The 2024–2025 outcome data demonstrate the strong performance and continued effectiveness of the Master of Science in Rehabilitation Counseling at Western Oregon University. With 13 graduates, an 85% degree completion rate, a 73% credentialing exam pass rate, and a 100% employment rate within three months, the program consistently meets or exceeds its Academic Quality Indicator (AQI) thresholds. These outcomes indicate that students are progressing successfully through the curriculum, demonstrating competence across CACREP-aligned domains, and transitioning into professional rehabilitation counseling roles with confidence. Employer and site supervisor feedback further affirms that graduates are well-prepared, ethical, culturally responsive, and clinically skilled.

These results reflect the program's intentional and ongoing efforts to support student achievement. Faculty systematically review AQIs, Key Performance Indicators, and stakeholder feedback to guide curriculum improvement and enhance student learning experiences. Recent actions include strengthening theory-to-practice integration, improving early clinical skills preparation, redesigning summer coursework for accessibility, expanding trauma-informed instruction, and integrating micro-learning modules to support national exam readiness. The program also maintains robust community partnerships to ensure a 100% practicum and internship placement rate, offering diverse and supportive fieldwork opportunities. Together, these strategic efforts contribute to the high levels of success demonstrated by graduates during this evaluation year.
